International Justice Mission's work in Ghana involves rescuing children from slavery in the fishing industry. They help law enforcement locate children held as slaves and work with Ghanaian police and anti-trafficking forces to rescue them, and bring the children to a safe place. Their work includes restoring survivors, bringing criminals to justice, and strengthening justice systems.

Supports 11 local partners who are bringing the Gospel to local communities through ministries like Bridgeport Rescue Mission, Pivot, and Urban Impact.

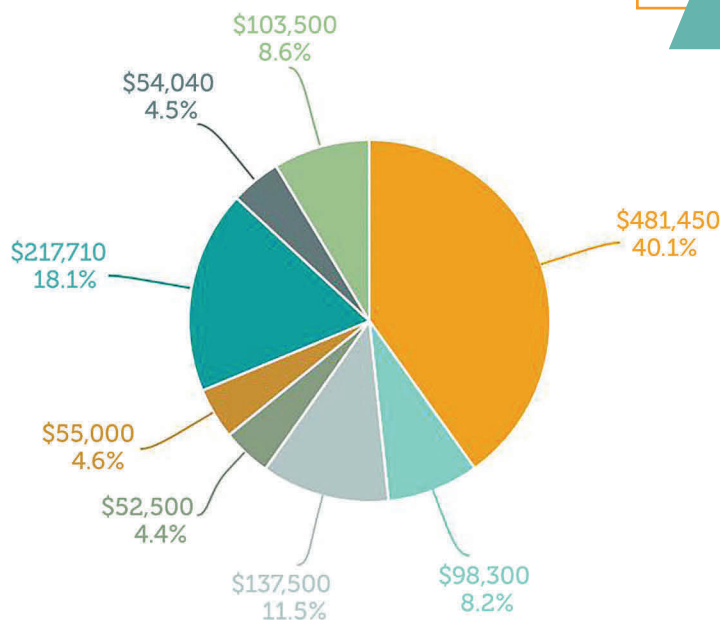
