FREQUENCY

Luke 5:4-11

⁴ When Jesus had finished speaking, he said to Simon Peter "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." ⁵ Simon Peter answered, "Teacher, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets.

⁶ When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break. ⁷ So they signaled to James and John, their partners in the other boat, to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.



Luke 5:4-11

⁸ When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "*Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man*!" ⁹ For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, ¹⁰ and so were James and John, Simon Peter's partners. Then Jesus said to Simon Peter, "*Don't be afraid; from now on you will catch men."* ¹¹ So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed Him.



John 21:3-6

1. When Jesus tells you to do something - Obey.

Faith is obeying His voice before it makes sense; before you know how it all works out.



John 21:7-9

Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" As soon as Simon Peter heard John say, "It is the Lord," he wrapped his outer garment around him and jumped into the water. 8 The other disciples followed in the boat, towing the net full of fish, for they were not far from shore, about a hundred yards. 9 When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread.

Jesus said, "Take care of my sheep." ¹⁷ The third time he said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, "Do you love me?" He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Feed my sheep."
