'Jonah, I have a mission for you...' God

"The word of the Lord came to Jonah...'Go to the great city of Nineveh and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before me.'" Jonah 1:1-2 (NIV)



'God, I'm running away from you...' Jonah

"But Jonah ran away from the Lord...and sailed to Tarshish to flee from the Lord."

Jonah 1:3 (NIV)



'God, I'm running away from you...' Jonah

"So they (the sailors) asked him, "Tell us, who is responsible for making all this trouble for us? What kind of work do you do? Where do you come from? What is your country? From what people are you? Jonah 1:8 (NIV)



'I messed up...' Jonah

"He answered, "I am a Hebrew and I worship the Lord, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry land. "This terrified them and they asked, "What have you done?" (They knew he was running away from the Lord, because he had already told them so.) Jonah 1:9,10 (NIV))



Quick Thoughts Concerning Sin

When I am in the depths, call out to God.

"But I, with a song of thanksgiving, will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed I will make good. Salvation comes from the Lord." Jonah 2:9,10 (NIV) "



"If there are 1,000 steps between you and God, God will take 999 of them and leave the last one for you."

Nineveh: "They believed God. They declared a fast, and all of them from the greatest to the least, put on sackcloth." Jonah 3:5 (NIV)



'Nineveh, I will not destroy you.' God

"When God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, he had compassion and did not bring upon them the destruction he had threatened." Jonah 3:10 (NIV)



'What's your problem God?' Jonah 'What's your problem Jonah?' God

"But Jonah was greatly displeased and became angry. He prayed to the Lord, "O Lord, is this not what I said when I was still at home? That is why I was so quick to flee Tarshish.
