THE JOB: Black Rock’s Student Ministry Intern will develop and inspire students to be leaders and world changers through helping to develop weekly programming, building relationships with students, and finding new and creative ways to communicate to the next generation. The intern will also be a part of the grander Fellowship program at BRC and be developed in their character and craft through the life-building activities formed by the Intern Coordinator.

WHO WE’RE LOOKING FOR:

- A person who loves Jesus, walks in integrity, and holds fast to the Word of God.
- A person who loves students!
- A person who has a passion for the local church and is called to ministry.
- Someone who wants to help students grow in their relationship with God.
- A person who is a team player who thrives working alongside a team of people.
- A person who is teachable and yet self-motivated towards the accomplishing of tasks.
- A person who is innovative in reaching the next generation.

THE WORK YOU’LL DO:

- Owning our weekly ministry programs (i.e. building/planning, leading, teaching and executing) alongside our student ministry staff.
 - Building/Planning: Develop and execute the ministry programs as well as create a schedule for all aspects of ministry they are involved with leading.
 - Leading/Executing: Assist the ministry with planning and executing our large one-off group events (i.e. buying supplies, communication to students and parents, various aspects of execution, etc). Effectively create, run and participate in active games for our midweek programming.
 - Teaching: Work with our Next Gen teaching staff to create and select content. (Develop content to teach for Sunday Morning Middle School Class).
- Able to lift and carry 50+ lbs.
- Able to drive church vehicles (Must be 21 years of age to drive vehicles).
- Build relationships with students through a “one-on-one” discipleship process.
- Attend all Intern and weekly staff meetings.
