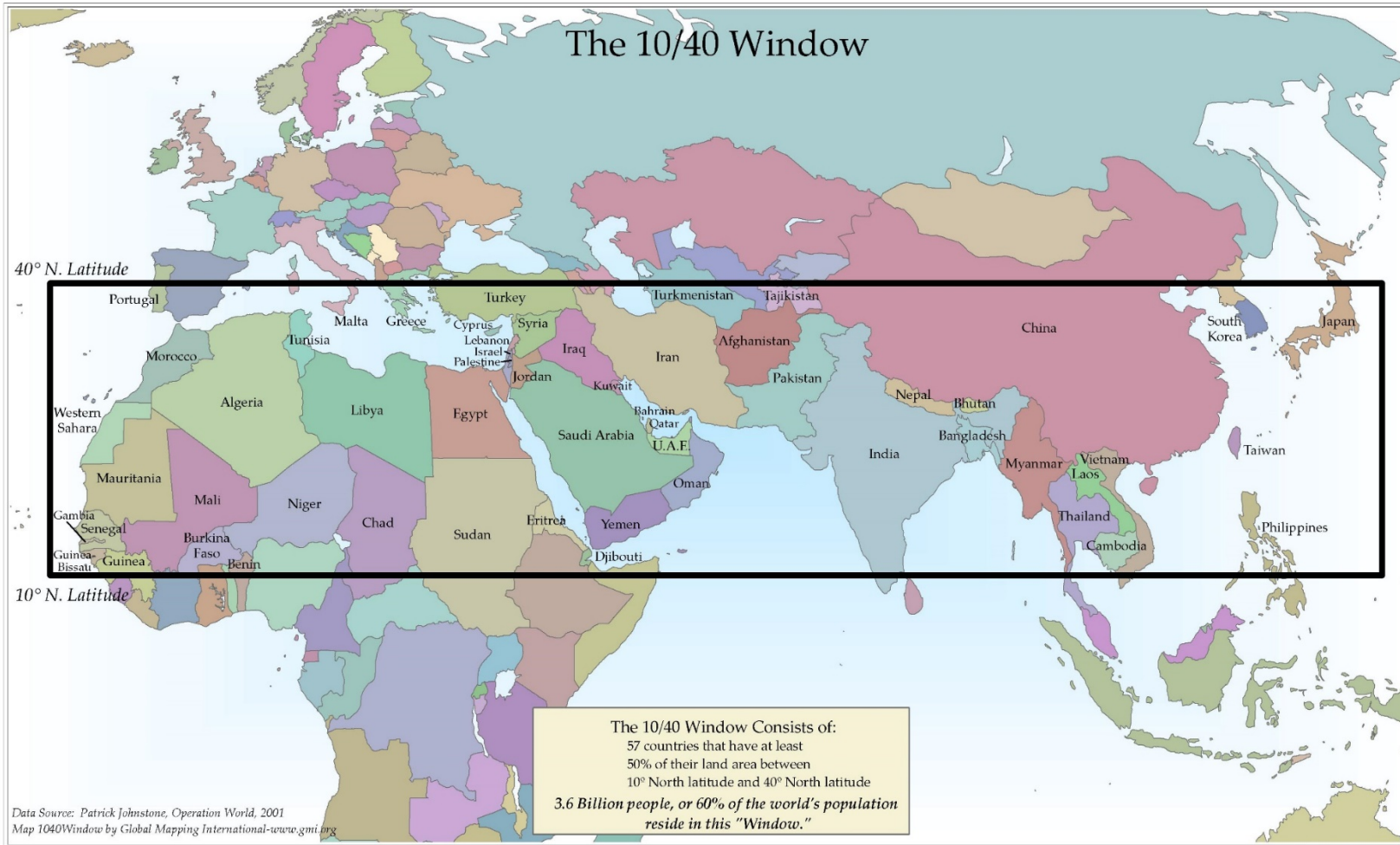

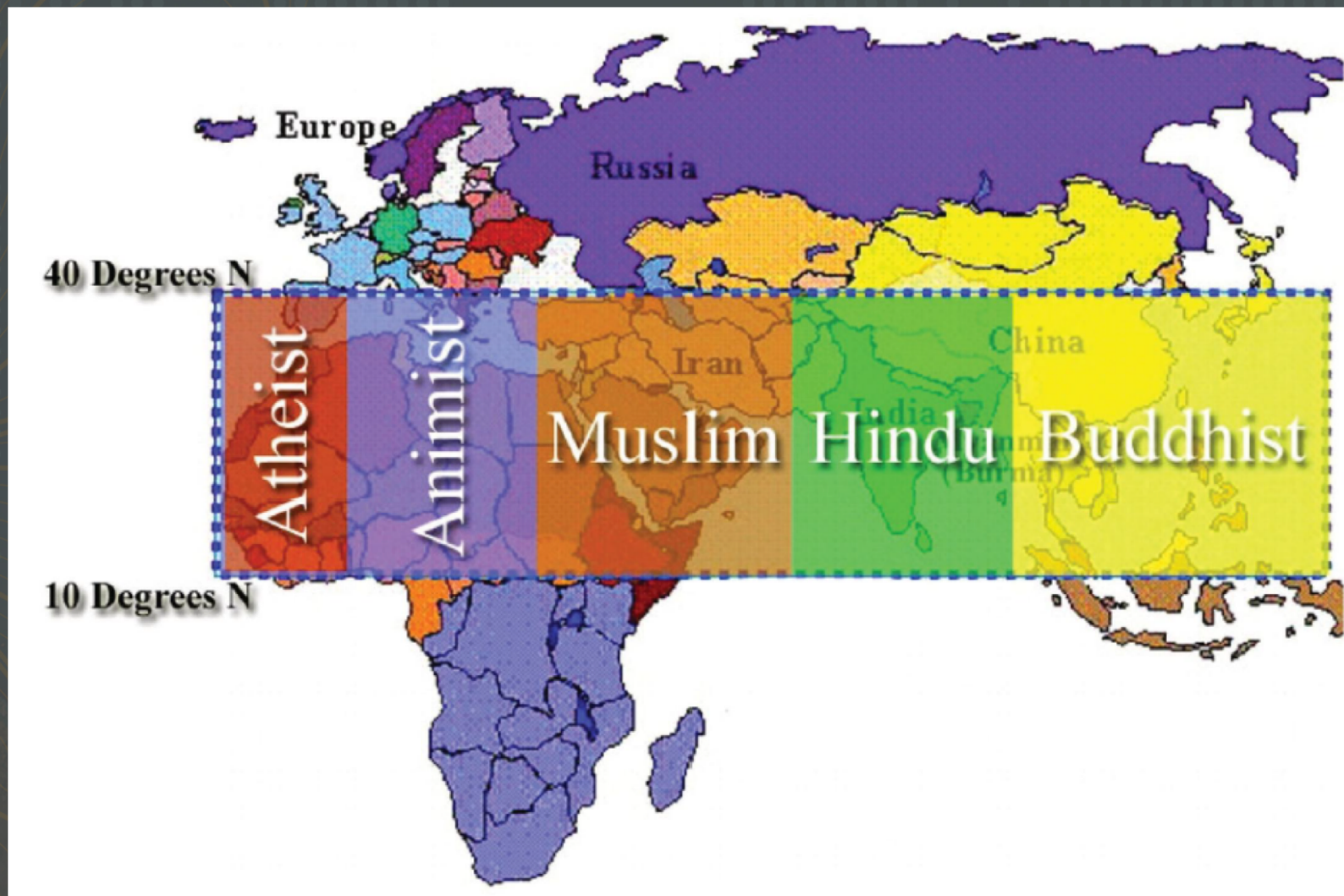
The 10/40 Window

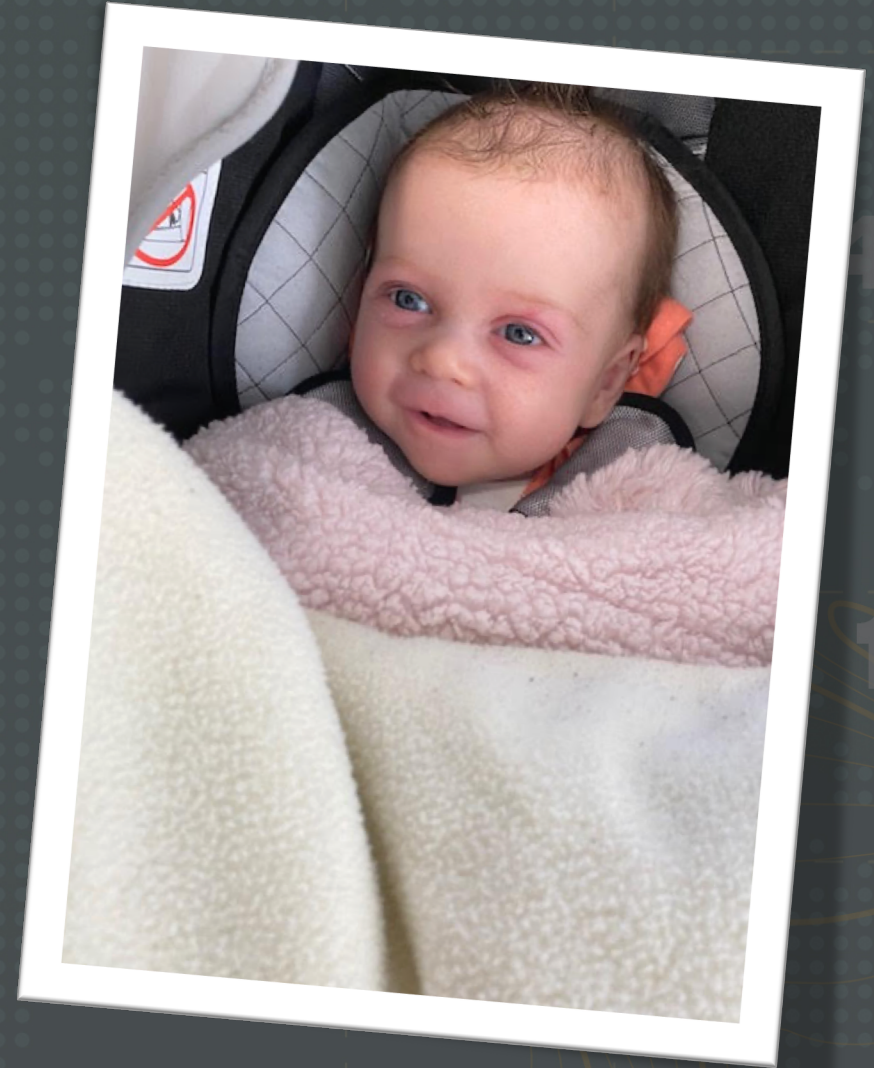

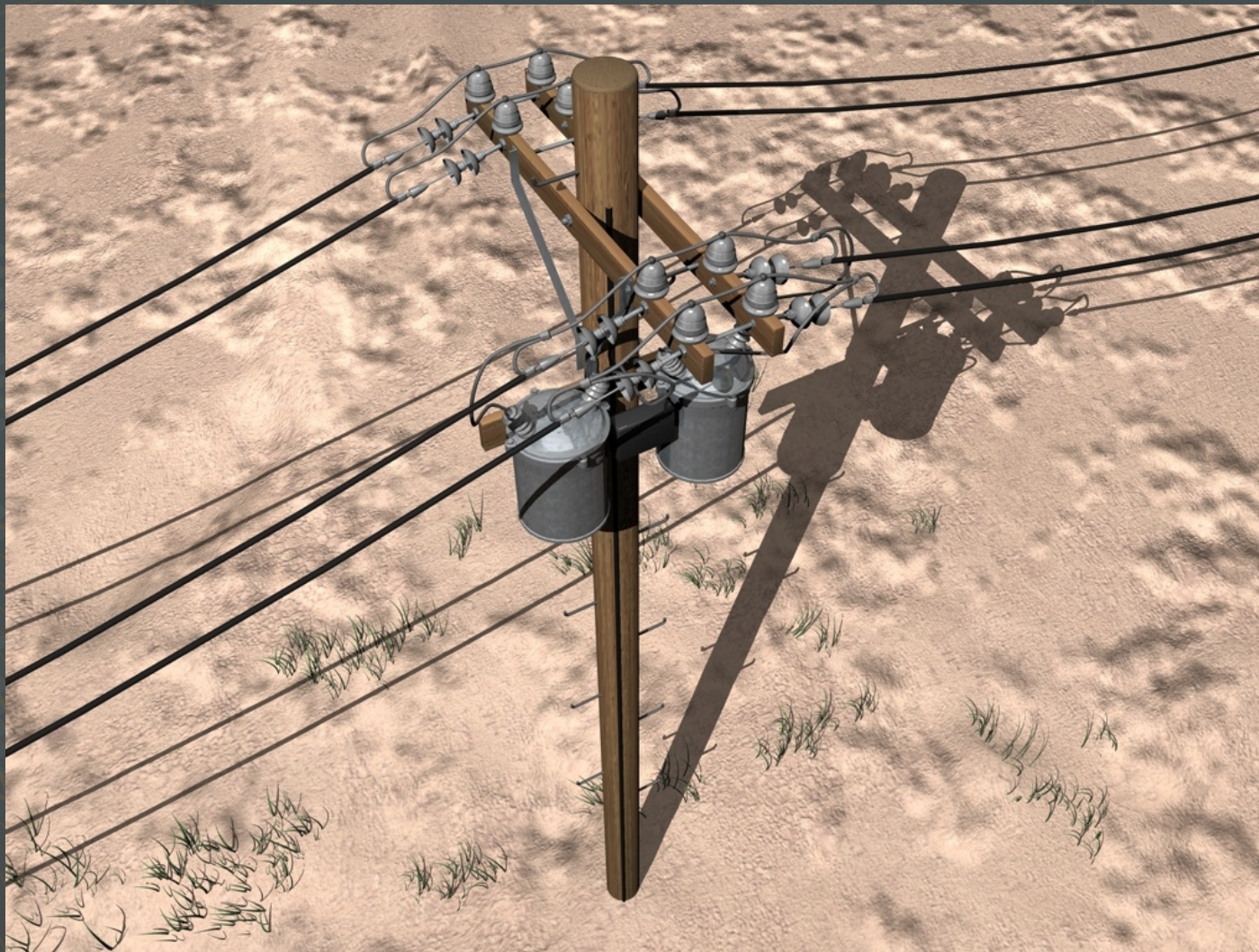
Black Rock Global Missions - Four Strategic Priorities
